Sub: TECHNICAL EDUCATION - Starting of ^{S. financing} new Polytechnics during 1997-98 - Permission to run the Polytechnics during 1997-98 and to allow the students admitted during 1997-98 to write the examination - Granted.

I am directed to invite your attention to the references cited.

2. The Government in their letter first cited, have informed you their decision, that the 12 Polytechnics for which the All India Council for Technical Education has granted approval for the year 1997-98, need not be permitted to start their institutions during 1997-98, since the centralised admission for self-financing Polytechnics in the State was over by 27.11.97.

3. The Government have examined the representations received from the new self-financing Polytechnics (approved by the All India Council for Technical Education during 1997-98) that, they have admitted the students in time and they have covered the required number of term days, and have requested the Government to permit them to sponsor the students so admitted to appear in the ensuing Board Examinations.

4. In your letter third cited, you have reported that, the Polytechnics permitted by the All India Council for Technical Education during 1997-98 have admitted candidates before the expiry of last date, i.e., 27.11.97 prescribed by the Directorate and that these institutions have prepared the candidates for the ensuing Board Examinations. Except one institution, viz., P.V. Polytechnic, Tindivanam, all the other Polytechnics have admitted candidates into different All India Council for Technical Education approved courses. The High Court has also issued directions to the Government to consider the representations of the managements of Polytechnics and to pass orders within two weeks.

5. The Government have examined the matter carefully and have decided to permit the students admitted in the following 12 self-financing Polytechnics during 1997-98, to appear for the ensuing Board Examination, as special case, in the interest of the students, subject to their eligibility for appearing for the Board Examination:-

1. Thirupathur Polytechnic, Thirupathur, Vellore District.
2. Sri Raghavendra Polytechnic, Komrapalayam.
3. Sengunther Institute of Technology, Tiruchengode.
4. Sri Muthalamma Polytechnic, Paramakudi.
5. Marugesan Institute of Technology, Karipatti, Salem.
6. Sun Institute of Technology, Nagercoil.
7. Sembodai R.V. Polytechnic, Sembodai.
8. SCAD Gramodhaya Polytechnic, Cheranmahadevi.
9. Suguna Polytechnic, Kalapatti, Coimbatore.
10. KAR Polytechnic, M.C. Road, Ambur.
11. Sri Ayyappa Polytechnic, Vridhachalam.
12. Aarthi Polytechnic, Tiruchengode.

The admission will be made in accordance with Regulations notified by the AICTE vide GSR 476(E) dated 20.05.1994 based on the hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 04.02.1993 with regard to WP(C) No. 697 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishnan JP and other etc. V/s. State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgements. No Management/Institute/Trust or Society shall announce admissions directly under any circumstances. Any action contrary to this provision taken by the Institute will make it liable to be derecognised.

Further in the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of the norms and standards as prescribed by the AICTE, the Council shall take further action to withdraw approval, and the liability arising out of such withdrawal of approval will be solely that of Management/Trust/Society and/or Institution.

The Council may inspect/ visit the Institution any time it may deem fit to note the progress/ compliance.

The attention of the management is drawn to the fact that the approval given now is only for one academic session, at the end of which an expert committee shall visit to assess if the norms and standards as stipulated by AICTE are fulfilled, and only then will the continuation or otherwise shall be intimated.

You are requested to kindly monitor the progress made by these institutions for fulfillment of norms and standards of the Council and keep the concerned Regional Office and AICTE, New Delhi informed.


